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Purpose of Job

As a Data & Digital Technician you will work within the Data & Digital Team, where you will leverage data science, data analytics and automation tools, to identify, design, implement and test innovative digital solutions with the aim of streamlining processes and driving efficiency within the firm.

Main Activities

- Assist in the identification of business processes suitable for automation
- Work with internal stakeholders to document and map the current 'As Is' business process
- Work with internal stakeholders and subject matter experts to document the improved 'To Be' business process ready for automation
- Implement & test automations using tools from UiPath and the Microsoft Power platform
- Monitor and maintain existing / recently deployed automations
- Work with stakeholders and subject matter experts to assist in identifying business problems and defining the business goal of any data projects
- Assist in the preparation of data, including collection, cleaning, integration and normalisation of the data
- Perform Exploratory Data Analysis (EDA) to better understand the data, the patterns within it and the relationship between variables
- Assist in creating and evaluating models and interpreting the results
- Communicate and present the results to different stakeholders within the firm
- Produce clear documentation for any developed solution
- Providing support and further development to existing projects and automations

- An understanding of the ethical issues around gathering and working with data
- Strong mathematical ability

- Web development knowledge of JavaScript / HTML / CSS
